Biography

Dr Danson Yeo is a Consultant Upper Gastrointestinal Surgeon with the Department of General Surgery, Tan Tock Seng Hospital. Danson obtained his Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery (MBBS) from Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore in 2009. He completed his specialist training in General Surgery in 2017, and was admitted as a Fellow to the Royal College to Surgeons (Edinburgh). Danson completed the National Health Group Clinical Scientist Preparatory Program in 2019, and was subsequently awarded the National Medical Research Council Clinician-Scientist Individual Research Grant New Investigator Grant (CS-IRG NIG) in 2019 to investigate the effect of intra-gastric Botulinum Toxin injection on weight loss. He is an adjunct lecturer with both Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine and Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine. Danson's research interests are in obesity and metabolic syndrome, understanding the mechanisms of weight loss and diabetes resolution after bariatric surgery, as well as esophageal and gastric cancer.
