Biography

Associate Professor Cheok has had a distinguished career in psychiatry spanning over 20 years. Prior to his current appointment, he served as Vice Chairman Medical Board at the National Addictions Management Service, IMH, and Deputy Chairman Medical Board at Khoo Teck Puat Hospital, leading their Department of Psychological Medicine. His research portfolio includes significant grants, notably a current National Health Innovation Centre grant (\$804,120) focused on remote psychiatric care management, and past projects including a MINDEF-funded study on depression biomarkers (\$3.5M) and involvement in a \$25M National Translational Clinical Research Grant. His research covers substance abuse, youth mental health, and military psychiatry, with notable publications on cannabis use, autism and national service in Singapore. A/P Cheok received the Public Service Medal (PBM), IMH Clinical Mentorship Award 2021, and the National Leadership Award for digital mental health implementation. He was also part of the team that received the 2023 National Healthcare Group Team Achievement Award.
