Biography

Dr Yao chairs the elderly section in the Care Transformation Office and the Code Blue committee in IMH. He is also the co-director for the psychogeriatric community team — Aged Psychiatric Community Assessment & Treatment Service (APCATS). He had led APCATS to build up the capability of primary care team in Hougang Polyclinic to set up a dementia clinic. He also has special interest in management of frailty, integration of care and quality improvement. His involvement in research includes publishing a paper on the effectiveness of a resuscitation course catered for a tertiary psychiatric hospital and helping to establish a departmental standing database to support future research and data analysis. In addition to his clinical and academic contributions, he was frequently featured in national media and news outlets, advocating for dementia care and mental health awareness. He had led my team in developing a novel mobile application (play2care) that uses gamification to train caregivers in effective communication strategies with persons living with dementia.
