Dr Justin Tang is a Senior Consultant in the Department of Cardiology, Khoo Teck Puat Hospital. He received his medical degree from the National University of Singapore and completed his advanced specialty training in Cardiology in Singapore. He completed a 3-year clinical research fellowship in Edinburgh and was awarded a PhD from the University of Edinburgh. He is a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians Edinburgh, and a fellow of the American College of Cardiology.

His clinical interest is in familial hypercholesterolemia (FH), hypertension and cardiometabolic disease. He has been involved as site principal investigator for the ODYSSEY OUTCOMES and VICTORION-2 PREVENT trials.

Dr Tang served as the Director of the Coronary Care Unit, KTPH from 2017-2024. He is a Member of the Agency for Care Effectiveness (ACE) hyperlipidemia management Expert Group, Ministry of Health (2023-2025). Dr Tang was awarded the Commendation Medal (COVID-19). In 2024, he was part of the team awarded the NHG Excellence in Action Award (FHCare Team). He is involved in teaching and is the teaching lead for Cardiology at KTPH.
