Biography

Dr Chen Kok Pun is a consultant gastroenterologist and clinical informatics leader at Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore. He earned his M.B.B.S from the National University of Singapore (2012) and subsequently obtained his MRCP qualifications from London, becoming a Fellow of the Academy of Medicine Singapore.

Dr Chen's commitment to innovation is exemplified through his prestigious fellowship with Singapore Biodesign (2020), a global affiliate of Stanford's Byers Center for Biodesign, where he developed expertise in medical device innovation and healthcare technology. His dedication to advancing healthcare through technology led to his appointment as a GovTech Open Government Products HealthTech Fellow (2023) and his current role as Assistant Chief Clinical Informatics Officer at TTSH.

His research portfolio includes publications in artificial intelligence applications in gastroenterology, with notable work on computer-aided diagnosis systems (CADe) for polyp histology prediction. Dr Chen has secured multiple grants totalling over SGD 150,000 for innovative healthcare projects, including digital health and molecular profiling initiatives.

Beyond clinical practice, Dr Chen actively contributes to medical education as clinical faculty at both Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine and NUS Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, whilst serving as an educator at NHG's Centre for Medical Technologies and Innovations, fostering the next generation of clinician-innovators.
